



## **Manly United Football Club Code of Conduct (Player)**

In addition to the Football Australia Player Code of Conduct, all Manly United FC players must comply with this Code and all applicable Australian laws (Federal and State).

### **Manly United FC players must:**

- Play and train by the laws of the game, respectfully.
- Never abuse or disrespect match officials, coaches, club officials, players, or spectators.
- Not bully, abuse, or exploit others.
- Treat everyone with respect, courtesy, and dignity.
- Always give my best in training and games.
- Inform the Club of any injuries or health issues affecting my performance.
- Avoid overloading my body through excessive sports participation.
- Notify the Club of any absences in advance.
- Support a positive and respectful team culture.
- Commit to achieving team and Club goals.
- Follow all reasonable directions from coaches and officials.
- Uphold the Club's reputation at all times.
- Never smoke, drink alcohol, or use drugs at training or games, or attend while under the influence.
- Not train, trial, or play for another club without written permission.
- Avoid negative comments in the public domain (including but not limited to social media) about Manly United, MWFA, FNSW, or others involved in the game.

**Breaches of this Code may result in penalties, including warnings, immediate deregistration without refund or contract termination, at the discretion of Manly United FC.**



## **Manly United Football Club Code of Conduct (Parents and Spectators)**

As a parent/guardian, you are an important part of our community and are expected to follow this Code while your child is registered with Manly United FC.

### **Parents and Guardians must:**

- Abide by FA's National Code of Conduct and Grievance Regulations.
- Treat all players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect — no abuse or harassment.
- Support players positively — no sideline coaching or criticism of officials, coaches, or players.
- Praise effort over outcome and help my child learn from challenges.
- Respect the Club's policies, philosophy, and team environment.
- Stay off the field and out of change rooms unless invited by a Club official.
- Be a role model for behaviour and resilience.
- Use contact details only for Club-approved team matters.
- Keep the Club informed of any injuries, health concerns, or absences in advance.
- Encourage a positive, respectful Club culture.
- Ensure their child understands and follows the Player Code of Conduct.
- Never damage the Club's reputation through words or actions.
- Avoid negative comments in the public domain (including but not limited to social media) about Manly United, MWFA, FNSW, or others involved in the game.

**Breaches of this Code may result in penalties, up to and including the deregistration of the player without refund, at the discretion of Manly United FC.**
