



Manly United Football Club Code of Conduct (Player)

In addition to the Football Australia Player Code of Conduct, all Manly United FC players must comply with this Code and all applicable Club and Football Australia requirements.

As a Manly United FC player, I will:

- Play and train by the laws of the game, respectfully.
- Never abuse or disrespect match officials, coaches, club officials, players, or spectators.
- Treat everyone respectfully and not bully, intimidate, exclude or behave in a way that makes others feel unsafe.
- Treat everyone with respect, courtesy, and dignity.
- Always give my best in training and games.
- Inform the Club of any injuries or health issues affecting my performance.
- Avoid overloading my body through excessive sports participation.
- Notify the Club of any absences in advance.
- Support a positive and respectful team culture.
- Commit to achieving team and Club goals.
- Follow all reasonable directions from coaches and officials.
- Uphold the Club's reputation at all times.
- Never smoke, vape, drink alcohol, or use drugs at training, matches or Club activities.
- Not train, trial, or play for another club without written permission.
- Avoid negative comments in the public domain (including but not limited to social media) about Manly United, MWFA, FNSW, or others involved in the game.

Players are also expected to comply with Club policies and safeguarding requirements available on the Club website and CoachBetter.

Breaches of this Code may result in disciplinary action, including warnings, suspension, deregistration or termination of involvement with the Club.
